

RE: HPE Catholic Resources

The following provides an update on the materials and resources that have been produced to support the efforts of Ontario Catholic schools in implementing the revised Health & Physical Education (HPE) curriculum.

Print Material Orders

As of the end of last week, all school boards received the printed parent information booklets that were ordered in bulk through the Institute for Catholic Education. The delivery of the material took a little longer than was originally communicated because the order was larger than anticipated. In fact, all 29 Catholic school boards participated in the bulk print-run, ordering more than 450,000 copies of the resources for Catholic parents across Ontario.

Additional Supports

A number of materials have been developed, and are posted on the ICE website, to assist principals and teachers to respond to parent inquiries accurately and confidently.

The attached chart identifies the HPE resource materials that have been developed. The resources that are most applicable at this time are found in Phase 1: the PowerPoint presentations intended for use by principals with their teaching staff, and the PowerPoint presentations intended for use by principals with their parent communities. The elementary presentations are currently posted on the ICE website. The comparable secondary presentations will be posted by the end of this week.

The remainder of the resources, listed in Phase 2, may be of more use to schools later in the fall as the classroom resources become available.


Next Steps

We are still anticipating that the classroom resources will be released by early November, 2015.



An information/training session has been scheduled for Friday, November 20, 2015. Additional information about the registration process for board teams will be provided over the next couple of weeks.






