Theme One — Created and Loved by God

Key Expectations	Sample Demonstrations/Activities
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> recognize and appreciate the ways in which each of them is a unique person whom God created and loves (Topic 1) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> contribution to class discussion of the ways in which each of them is unique contribution to the creation of a classroom poster celebrating their identity as unique people whom God created and loves
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> identify aspects of their past development and look ahead to future growth and development (Topic 2) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> contribution to class discussion of past development, and of differences in the way each unique person develops written questionnaire about growth and development (BLM #1)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> recognize the importance of feelings, their expression, and the choices they have in the way feelings are expressed (Topic 3) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> contribution to class discussion of common feelings, the value of expressing feelings, and choices in the way feelings are expressed written response to situations involving the expression of feelings (BLM #2)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> demonstrate an understanding of how they respond to challenging and uncomfortable situations identify strategies for coping with challenging and uncomfortable situations (Topic 3) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> identify appropriate responses to stressful situations
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> identify and appreciate their personal qualities and gifts, and those of others (Topic 4) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> contribution to class discussion of personal qualities and gifts written questionnaire about personal qualities and gifts and those of another child (BLM #3)
